CESA Affiliate Membership

Any public or nonprofit organization that is not eligible for CESA Core Membership can apply for CESA Affiliate Membership. Among the types of organizations that are eligible for CESA Affiliate Membership are NGOs, universities, economic development organizations, and technology transfer offices, as well as cities, counties, and states that do not have significant dedicated clean energy funding. Affiliates must be approved both by the CESA state member in which the entity is located, if applicable, and the CESA Board of Directors.
